ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. An applicant must be a New York State Mason in Good Standing, his spouse, widow, son, daughter, grandson and granddaughter. Surviving children of a deceased Mason are also eligible to apply for a personal scholarship grant.
2. The applicant must provide proof that he/she is currently enrolled and participating in an accredited educational institution (i.e. college, university or technical training school) or plans to begin his/her studies in the next semester. In the later case, the applicant must provide a letter of acceptance from the educational institution and proof that the offer was accepted.
3. The applicant must provide proof of their Masonic affiliation.
4. The applicant must provide a copy of their high school and college transcripts including the most recent semester. The high school transcript may be waived if the applicant has completed at least two years of college.
5. The application must be sponsored by a sitting Master of a duly constituted Lodge in the State of New York.
6. Applicants may be asked to appear for a personal interview at a time and location to be announced.
7. All applications for these scholarship awards must be on forms provided by the Ellis - Henningsen Scholarship Trust.
8. The deadline for submission of applications for the academic year is December 10th, 2005
